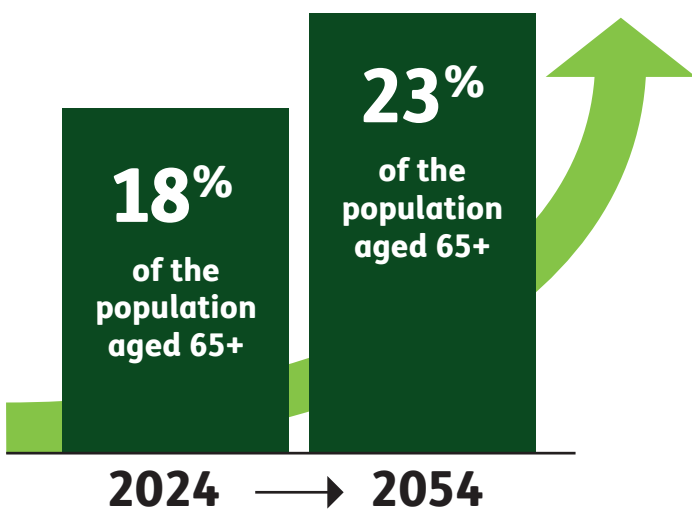

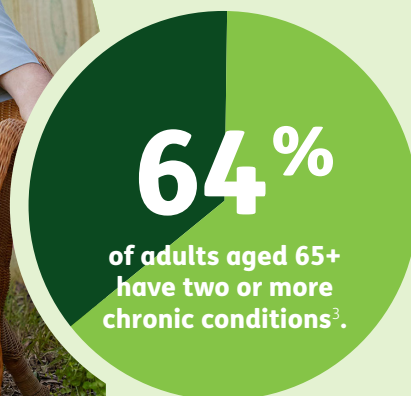
A graying nation

- Americans aged 65+ make up 18% of the population¹
- By 2054, this will climb to an estimated 23% of the population¹
- Between 2024 and 2027, more Americans will turn 65 than at any other point in history²

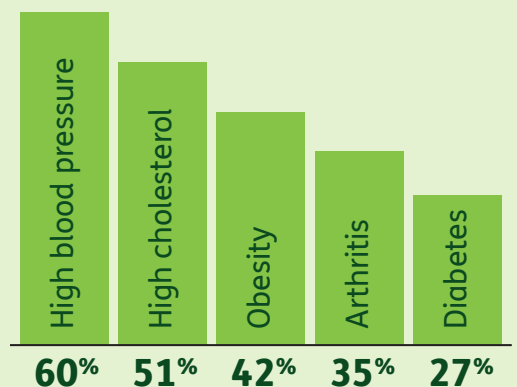
Leading to a spike in the Medicare-eligible population
